The story of **Caleb and the spies** shows us a clear choice between **living by fear or living by faith**. When the spies saw the promised land, they focused on the giants and said, *“We are not able”* (Numbers 13:31). Their fear caused them to forget God’s power and promises. Caleb, however, looked at the same land and trusted that God was with them. He believed that obedience and faith mattered more than how big the obstacles looked.

This story teaches us that **fear exaggerates problems**, but **faith remembers who God is**. When we let fear lead, we stop moving forward. When we let faith lead, we step into what God has already promised — even when it feels scary.
